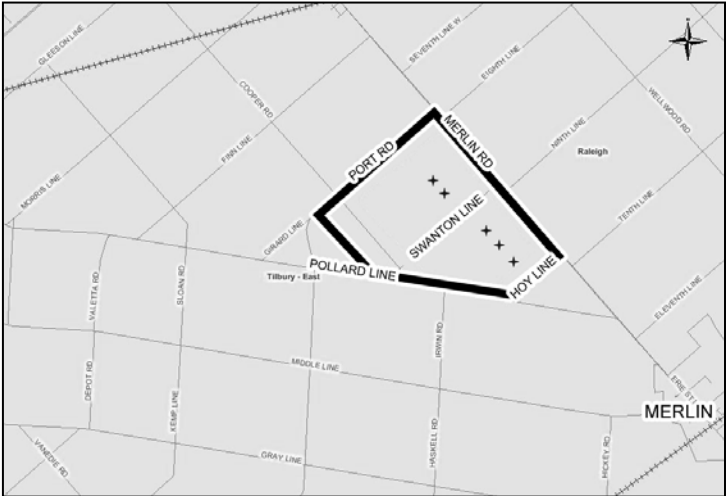




NOTICE OF COMPLETION FOR THE SWANTON LINE WIND FARM

Gengrowth LP1 (Gengrowth) is a Canadian energy company dedicated to the creation of small-scale renewable energy projects. Gengrowth is proposing to construct a small scale wind farm, the **Swanton Line Wind Farm** (the "Project"), located south of the Town of Fletcher in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, Ontario (please refer to inset map – stars indicate approximate turbine positions and the outlined area indicates area of study).

The project **Swanton Line Wind Farm** is being developed under the Government of Ontario's Standard Offer Program and, if approved, will consist of five wind turbines generating 10 Megawatts (MW) of emission-free energy. Electricity generated by the project will be collected via a low-voltage underground electrical system and distributed to the Hydro One Network at one connection point on existing electrical distribution lines.



The environmental screening was conducted in accordance with the requirements of both the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act (CEAA)* and the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act (EAA)* and is subject to the environmental screening process for electricity/wind farm projects. The applicable guidelines that are being followed are the "Environmental Impact Statement Guidelines for Screenings of Inland Wind Farms" under the CEAA and 'Category B' projects of the "Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Electricity Projects (March 2001)" provided by the Ministry of the Environment.

The Federal and Provincial environmental assessment processes include public and review agency consultation, evaluation of alternatives, assessment of the impacts of the proposed project and identification of measures to mitigate any adverse impacts. The results of the Screening Process confirm that there are no significant negative environmental effects anticipated from the project.

This Notice of Completion places the "Environmental Impact Statement / Environmental Screening Report" on public record for the mandatory 30-day review period. Gengrowth intends to proceed with the project subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, mitigation measures, commitments and other approvals (as identified in the Environmental Screening Report). Interested parties should provide written comments to Mr. Jeffrey Segal, Gengrowth LP1 by February 27th, 2008.

If concerns arise regarding this project that cannot be resolved in discussions with Gengrowth, a person/party may request that the Director of the Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch, Ministry of the Environment make an order for the project to be elevated to an Environmental Review (within the Environmental Screening Process) or to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a "Part II Order"), which addresses individual environmental assessments. Elevation Requests must be made in accordance with the provisions set out in the Ministry of the Environment's "Environmental Screening Process for Electricity Projects". The Director must receive Requests, at the address below, for elevation by February 27th, 2008.
